

# ESSER III Grant Stakeholder Input Survey


Tidehaven ISD will apply for a grant from the Texas Education Agency (TEA) based on funds they received from the American Rescue Plan (ARP) Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund (ESSER III). The total amount of funding that Tidehaven ISD is eligible for is \$1,964,645. TEA will release 2/3 of these funds (\$1,309,763) after we complete the required application and submit a "Safe Return to In-Person Instruction and Continuity of Services Plan." The additional 1/3 of the funds are scheduled for release at a later date once TEA receives approval from the federal granting agency. Our plan must include stakeholder input on how we expect to safely return students to school and provide instructional continuity, and a plan on how these funds should be utilized.

Tidehaven ISD is seeking input from stakeholders across the district to include TISD staff, parents, community, and students as we develop our plan. Your feedback and input is critical and will help inform our plan.

Responses to this survey are due by 5:00pm on Monday, June, 7, 2021 and will be considered as we develop our plan.




From your perspective, what are the top issues facing students in our district during the COVID-19 pandemic? (Check all that apply)


In your opinion, what are the biggest challenges to student learning due to the COVID-19 Pandemic? (Check all that apply)




What strategies have been most effective in supporting the needs of students at Tidehaven ISD during the COVID-19 pandemic? (Check all that apply)


In your opinion, what resources, tools, and/ or training supports would help Tidehaven ISD align classroom learning activities with independent student practice? (Check all that apply)
