**Summer Update**

**LBHS Summer Office Hours are Monday through Thursday from 8:30 am to 3:30 pm. We are closed on Fridays during the summer.**

**LBHS will be closed the week of June 30 through July 4, 2025.**

**Residency and PowerEnrollment Assistance** will be available July 24 from 12:00 pm to 5:00 pm. Notaries will be present to notarize paperwork and anyone who needs access to tech or assistance with completion of PowerEnrollment is welcome. We are here to help so don't hesitate to come with whatever questions you have!

Our **Back to Beckham** days will be the week of July 28 through July 31. You may complete registration and residency verification, students will get school ID and Chromebook, pay fees (school, course, parking, etc.), pick up the student course schedule, and see the school. Please park behind the school and enter through the gym lobby doors.

**\*You will NOT be allowed to move to other stations including schedule pickup until you have completed Registration and Residency Verification. THIS IS 100% ONLINE!**

- **ALL parents/guardians must register all students in the family online here: [CCSD Online Registration for ALL students](#).** We will have a list of who has registered to verify.
  
- **Residency verification information is here: [LBHS Yearly Residency Verification](#).** You will find all forms needed here and will need them completed to upload as a part of the CCSD Online Registration. If you have already completed the required residency verification for 25-26, all records should be uploaded. - **Pay fees online here: [LBHS RevTrak](#) (Will open on July 1, 2025.)** You may also pay with cash or check during Back to Beckham. If you pay online prior to Back to Beckham, please print your receipt or save it to your phone as it will be needed for verification.
  - Fees for specific classes may be added after PowerSchool reopens in July!
  - Instructional Fee is for all students and impacts all classes.
  - Parking is for 11th and 12th grade students only and only granted for those in good standing academically and behaviorally. Parking is a privilege.
  - Senior Painting Parking is in addition to the general parking fee.
  - Don't forget paperwork for early outs/late ins or parking for Juniors and Seniors ONLY! All can be found below and on the LBHS website!

*These can be completed at LBHS on the designated days but will take longer and there may be lines. **You will NOT be allowed to move to other stations including schedule pick up until you have completed Registration and Residency Verification with Mrs. Bottone.** She has a record of everyone that has already completed this process for the 2025-2026 school year.*

  - We have parking spots available for our 11th and 12th grade students but will open it to seniors first. Seniors will get a separate email with information. We do not have any space for student parking for sophomores. Be sure students have met all requirements to get a parking permit.
  - Alive at 25 courses are filling up quickly! Register your student at [SCNSC.ORG/A25](http://SCNSC.ORG/A25) to reserve a space so they will be ready to purchase their parking pass this summer. By registering your child for Alive at 25, they will receive comprehensive training on safe driving practices, defensive driving techniques, and the importance of making responsible choices behind the wheel. The course only needs to be completed once. If they completed it last year, they are good to go.
- All students (including Seniors) will have school portraits taken in September 2025. Details to come.
- As a reminder, 12th grade students will not be granted a late in or early out unless they have met College and Career Readiness requirements. **[College and Career Ready-LA/EO/CAS Pass Form](#)**
