Saint Jerome Regional School 2025-2026 Dress Code

For the 25-26 school year, School Spirit Wear and/or gym uniforms may be worn two days each week. Monday and Thursday of each week will be the school spirit dress down days. Dress Uniforms will be required on days that there is Mass or other special occasions. Those dates will be noted on the monthly calendar. All other days will require the everyday uniform or dress uniform. There may be other times throughout the year when extra dress down days are also granted.

All SJRS students are required to wear the approved SJRS uniform. SJRS believes that our manner of dress is a reflection of our Christian values. We strive to provide a positive environment that is conducive to learning. Any type of clothing, hair style, or accessory deemed inconsistent with these values is unacceptable and the administration reserves the final judgment in all dress code matters. The personal appearance of the entire student body represents the school to others in the community. All clothing should be identified with the student's name. It is advisable to identify all personal belongings. Official SJRS uniforms must be worn throughout the entire school year, beginning with the first day of school. Students will also have the option to wear "Summer" uniforms from April 1 through October 31. The Dress Code is listed below.

<p>BOYS ACCESSORIES/GROOMING POLICIES</p> <p>HAIR:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hair is to be kept stylishly neat and clean. • Excessively long hairstyles are not permitted. Long is defined by being over the top of the ears, over the shirt collar, and/or in the eyes. • Unnatural hair colors are not permitted • Words, numbers, or messages in hair are not permitted • Ponytails, mullets, and man-buns of any type are not permitted. • Hairbands to hold longer hair back are not permitted. • Extreme hairstyles are not permitted. • The administration has final determination on permitted hairstyles. <p>FACIAL HAIR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Boys are to be clean shaven at all times. Beards and Moustaches are not permitted. Only exception is a note from a dermatologist indicating a specific skin condition that prohibits shaving daily is an acceptable excuse. <p>JEWELRY/EARRINGS</p> <p>Boys are not permitted to wear earrings or ear-cuffs at any time during school day or when representing SJRS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Visible Piercings of any kind are not permitted. • Wallet chains are not permitted. • No more than one ring on each hand may be worn. • Students may wear promotional/inspirational bracelets, but should keep them limited to two or three on each wrist. • Electronic devices with internet capability such as Apple watches, etc. are not permitted to be worn or used. <p>CAPS/HOODS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Caps, hats, bandanas or hoods/hoodies are not permitted to be worn up in the building at any time. <p>MAKE-UP</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Boys are not permitted to wear nail polish or any type of make-up at any time. <p>CONTACTS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unusual or unnatural colored (Wild Eyes, etc) contact lenses are not permitted. <p>GROOMING</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All clothing worn in school is required to be clean, pressed, and not torn 	<p>GIRLS ACCESSORIES/GROOMING POLICIES</p> <p>HAIR:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hair is to be kept stylishly neat and clean. o Unusual and/or distracting hairstyles are not permitted o Unnatural hair colors, streaks, or highlights are not permitted o Words, numbers, or messages in hair are not permitted o Shaved heads or partially shaved haircuts are not permitted. o Extreme hairstyles are not permitted. • The administration has final determination on permitted hairstyles. <p>JEWELRY/EARRINGS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Girls may only wear one small post earring in each ear. Visible Body Piercings of any kind including NOSE RINGS are NOT PERMITTED. Exceptions will not be made for new piercings even if they are covered with a bandage. • Wallet chains are not permitted. • No more than one ring on each hand may be worn. • Students may wear promotional/inspirational bracelets, but should keep them limited to two or three on each wrist. • Electronic devices with internet capability such as Apple watches, etc. are not permitted to be worn or used. <p>CAPS/HOODS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Caps, hats, bandanas or hoods/hoodies are not permitted to be worn up in the building at any time. <p>MAKE-UP</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Glitter make-up and/or glitter hairspray are not permitted. • Makeup is not part of the regulation uniform. Only clear nail polish may be worn. <p>CONTACTS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unusual or unnatural colored (Wild Eyes, etc) contact lenses are not permitted. <p>GROOMING</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All clothing worn in school is required to be clean, pressed, and not torn
Dress Down Day Code	
<p>On dress down day, casual clothing may be worn. All clothing must be modest.</p>	
<p>The following items are not acceptable:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • torn jeans • Inappropriate slogans/language/graphics on clothing or any reference to drugs, alcohol tobacco or immoral activity. • flip flops or open back shoes • tank tops • short shorts 	
<p>Students are expected to come to school in a state of cleanliness. No tattoos are permitted. Personal appearance that constitutes a distraction is not permitted.</p>	

Final approval/ disapproval of ALL dress code issues are at the discretion of the Principal.
