REGIONAL SUPPORT CENTER

Newark, NY

Competitive Wages:

- Salaries offered are based on demonstrated education and experience.

Health Care:

- BOCES participates in the Finger Lakes Area School Health Plan (FLASHP) in order to offer employees rich health insurance coverage at affordable rates.

SPECIAL EDUCATION CENTERS

RED JACKET EDUCATION CENTER (RJEC)

Shortsville, NY

- **Focus:** Leveled literacy instruction utilizing the Really Great Reading Program, personalized learning, I-ready, IXL math instruction, Everyday Math, and social skills curriculum.
- RJEC serves students in grades K-6 and provides a safe, positive and successful school experience, while contributing to the student's physical, social and mental well being.

- **Focus:** Positive behavioral interventions and supports, therapeutic crisis intervention, NYS Regents prep and school to career opportunities.

SPECIAL EDUCATION CENTERS

NEWARK EDUCATION CENTER (NEC) Newark, NY

- **Focus:** Communication and physical mobility development through functional skills development, as well as therapeutic crisis intervention.
- NEC serves students in grades K-12 and is a student-centered educational site that focuses on collaboration to create opportunities and removes obstacles in order to provide each student with a quality learning experience.

FINGER LAKES ELEMENTARY SCHOOL (FLES) Gorham, NY

- **Focus:** Social, emotional, and academic development, individualized therapies and support, diploma and credential opportunities for students with diverse needs, including autism.
- Our full-day program serves students grades 3-5, with a wide range of abilities who need support in pragmatic language and communication, social awareness, academic learning, and behavior management. The program includes comprehensive therapies, such as occupational, physical, speech and language, and music therapy, as well as services from school psychologists, counselors, and social workers. Sensory rooms and movement breaks are provided to support sensory processing and maintain focus.

CAREER CREATIONS Newark, NY

- **Focus:** Inclusive and supportive atmosphere, fostering independent living skills, personalized interventions, and transition readiness with credential and diploma opportunities.
- Career Creation Extension of Newark Education Center serves students in grades 10-12+ with tailored initiatives for diverse needs. Programs include the Functional Skills Development (FSD) for self-care, communication, and pre-vocational skills, Communication and Physical Mobility Development (CPMD) for academic and mobility growth, and Academic, Communication, and Career Development (ACCD) for academic and social skill enhancement. The Career Creations/Transition Class (CC) prepares older students for employment and adult transition. Each program offers individualized instruction and hands-on learning.
