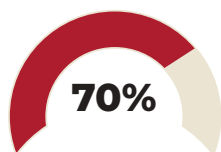

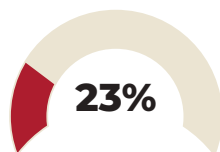

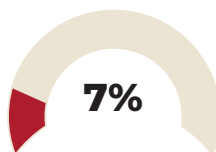
POST EDUCATION PLANS
