ACCESSING DUAL ENROLLMENT TRANSCRIPTS

The following are the links for accessing transcripts from our participating dual enrollment institutions. Students and parents are advised that all course grades must be posted before transcripts can be issued. Grades for 2024-25 are due to the institutions by Friday, June 27, 2025. Once grades are received, it will take about 14-21 days for all grades to be entered into the student accounts, making transcripts accessible by mid-July. Parents and students should follow the instructions provided on the institution's link; some schools use third-party transcript distributors.
