1. The Board of Education of Sayreville approved to award the bid for Parking Lot Upgrades and Expansion at the Dwight D. Eisenhower Elementary School to James R. Ientile, Inc. as the lowest responsible bidder for bids opened on May 29, 2025, in the amount \$1,239,121.00 for the base bid.

2. The Board of Education of Sayreville approved a withdrawal from Capital Reserve in the amount of \$1,239,121.00. The withdrawal of funds will be used for Parking Lot Upgrades and Expansion at the Dwight D. Eisenhower Elementary School. Any funds not expended will be returned to Capital Reserve.
