- (2) Athletic Events,
- (3) Field Trips, and
- (4) Summer Transportation.

WHEREAS, the District Administration and Assistant Superintendent for Business and Operations have recommended that the Board of Education of the Seaford Union Free School District award the above-described contracts to Educational Bus Company.
