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BUS DRIVER RESPONSIBILITIES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Follow designated routes and schedules• Maintain a clean and organized bus interior• Ensure student safety during loading and unloading• Communicate/reinforce expected behavior and redirect unexpected behavior• Report significant behavior incidents or safety concerns to Mrs. Mangun and Mr. Heist								
PARENT/GUARDIAN RESPONSIBILITIES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Accompany young children to and from bus stop (ELP and Kindergarten-aged riders)• Ensure children are at the designated stop 5 minutes before scheduled pickup time• Notify school of transportation changes (must go through front office)• Make other transportation arrangements if your child(ren) are riding to a location other than their home address - buses are at capacity• Connect with you child(ren) about their successes and challenges on the bus

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Supporting Behavior Challenges on the Bus

- Possible outcomes for unexpected behavior could include:
 - documented verbal and written warnings
 - individual support plan - check in's with principal and/or teacher(s)
 - school to home communication
 - school-based consequences (i.e., detention, written apology, supporting lunch staff with clean up)
 - short-term or longterm suspension from bus (includes field trips, sporting events, and other school related travel)

Hellgate Elementary School personnel, in partnership with Harlow's School Bus Service, are committed to ensuring safe and efficient transportation. Hellgate Elementary administrators will utilize the student handbook and leveled behavior rubric to determine appropriate supports and/or consequences involving student behavior on the bus.

All disciplinary actions prioritize student safety, as this is our top priority.
