Through the generosity of donors and volunteers who purchase supplies for individual needs, we help hundreds of students each year. We helped 670 students in 2024 and expect to help 800 in 2025.

Families that have financial difficulty purchasing school supplies for their K-12 students can complete the form on our website at <http://www.ProjectPencils.com/request.html> (open from June 1-July 31 each year), and we will post a request in our closed Facebook group for volunteers to "adopt" the students. We provide the specific supplies needed for each student based on their school and grade. The only information that is shared with our volunteers to help them purchase the correct supplies and a backpack for each student is: the student's school, grade, sex, and favorite colors (optional).
