Title I, Part A Improving Basic Programs

Planning Amount

\$1,780,990

Intent & Purpose: To provide all children significant opportunity to receive a fair, equitable, and high-quality education, and to close educational achievement gaps.

Title I, Part C- Migrant

Planning Amount

\$17,759

Intent & Purpose: Design and support programs that help migratory students overcome the challenges of mobility, cultural and language barriers, social isolation, and other difficulties associated with a migratory lifestyle.

Title II, Part A Supporting Effective Instruction

Planning Amount

\$239,122

Intent & Purpose: Provide educators (teachers, principals and school leaders) support in their work to improve the overall quality of instruction and ensure equity of educational opportunity for all students.

Title III, Part A ELA and Academic Achievement

Planning Amount

\$63,054

Intent & Purpose: To ensure that English learners (ELs) and immigrant students attain English proficiency and develop high levels of academic achievement in English. It is also to assist all English learners meet the same challenging State academic standards that all children are expected to meet.

Title IV, Part A Student Support & Academic Enrichment

Planning Amount

\$129,615

Intent & Purpose: To provide funding to improve the academic achievement of all students by increasing the capacity of LEAs, schools, and communities to: (1) provide all students with access to a well- rounded education; (2) improve school conditions for student learning; and (3) improve the use of technology and data to enhance academic outcomes and digital literacy of students.
