Twenty-one (21) AirChek radon test kits were placed on June 3, 2025, and were retrieved on June 5, 2025. The attached laboratory report identifies that radon concentrations in all tested locations meet the EPA guideline of 4 pCi/L for acceptable radon concentrations. As such, no additional mitigation or sampling is needed.
