SWSF Plan

In fiscal year 2025 we were granted \$80,709 in Student Wellness and Success Funds (SWSF). We utilize the SWSF to pay a portion of school based mental health workers.

We partner with the Summit County ESC, Red Oak Behavioral Health, and Child Guidance & Family Solutions for these services. Additionally, we consult with the ADM Board and Summit County ESC to refine our program and monitor progress. These staff members dedicate their time to providing various types of support to our students, including mental health, financial, educational, and more. These services are typical in coordination and conjunction with outside therapeutic support.

DPIA Plan

In fiscal year 2025 we were granted \$33,237 in Disadvantaged Pupil Impact Aide (DPIA) funds. We utilize the DPIA funds to pay a portion of school based mental health workers.

We partner with the Summit County ESC, Red Oak Behavioral Health, and Child Guidance & Family Solutions for these services. DPIA funds will be used to implement targeted interventions and support programs aimed at addressing the academic and socio-economic needs of disadvantaged students.
