Dear Haddon Township School District Community,

I hope this message finds you well. As we approach the close of another successful school year, I'm writing to **share an important safety update, celebrate several remarkable student accomplishments, and provide the most current version of the 2025–2026 school calendar.**

### **Student Safety Update**

On June 10th and 11th, police investigated reports involving a white, middle-aged male operating a black Honda Civic who was seen following elementary students as they walked home from school. The individual involved has been identified, and law enforcement continues to investigate in coordination with the Camden County Prosecutor's Office.

We remain in regular communication with the Haddon Township Police Department. Based on all current information, **there is no immediate threat to student safety.** However, out of an abundance of caution, an **increased police presence will continue** around our schools during arrival and dismissal through the end of the school year.

We encourage you to take this opportunity to review key safety practices with your children:

- Walk in groups whenever possible.
- Remain alert and avoid distractions like cell phones.
- Report any suspicious behavior or individuals to a trusted adult immediately.
- Follow a safe and familiar route home.
