2025-2026 STUDENT FEES ONLINE PAYMENT OPTION:

For your convenience, the online option for paying the 2025-2026 student fees, will be available as of **8:00 AM Monday, July 28th**. All major credit and debit cards are accepted through the secure site on our Web Store page. For instructions on how to use this system (Revtrak), please see the attached directions or visit the Cario website. Fees are \$60 per student.

HOW TO RECEIVE YOUR CHILD'S SCHEDULE:

If you use the online method to pay fees, you may do the following to receive a copy of your student's schedule:

Email cario_2025@charleston.k12.sc.us with a copy of your receipt attached and we will email your student's schedule back to you within 72 hours.

We will also offer a session for payment in person at Cario Middle School. All payments made in person must be in the form of cash or check. If you pay by check, please make it out to Thomas C. Cario Middle School.

This in-person payment session is scheduled for Monday, July 28th from 3:00-6:00 PM in Cario's Media Center. Once fees have been paid, you will receive a copy of your student's schedule.

NOTE: District nurses will be onsite to administer required (for 7th graders) T-DAP vaccinations.

REGISTRATION FOR RETURNING CCSD STUDENTS:

Completion of registration for the new school year is required. You can access your registration form by logging into your existing Parent Portal account and navigating to the left side of your dashboard and selecting "25-26 Returning Student Registration." The required residency document to upload is a current utility bill or statement.

Parents will not be going with your student as this is the best way for your student to get used to procedures. NEW TO CARIO UPPERCLASSMEN (7/8th GRADES) ORIENTATION:

Any 7th or 8th grade student who is new to Cario is invited to come to a Cario Orientation on August 6th from 2:30-4:00 PM in the Media Center. Parents and students are encouraged to attend. These new upperclassmen will get an overview of Cario and some resources to make this transition to a new school a little easier.

STUDENT ENTRY/EXIT AND TRAFFIC PATTERNS:

Students will enter the building through the media center doors in front of the school for car riders and through the 600 hallway by the gym parking lot for bus riders. The main office entrance will be reserved for those coming in late or for parents/community members. Please see the attached diagram for traffic flow around Cario for buses and cars. **NO students should ever be dropped off at CMS before 8:00 AM. Also, NO students should be dropped off or picked up outside these designated areas.** The best time for student drop-off is between 8:00-8:15 AM in front of the school. **Per district policy, the front office will not allow student sign-outs from 3:00-3:30 PM daily. Please make arrangements to pick up your children prior to 3:00 PM should they need to leave early.** If you need First Student bus route or bus pick-up information, please visit the transportation section of CCSD's main site.

EARLY DROP OFF:

We will be offering a limited capacity early drop-off this year. Space is limited and there is a \$50/month fee so that we can staff this program. Please use [this form](#) to register, knowing that space is limited. Priority will be given to CCSD staff who work in local schools, and those that were in the program last year.

T-DAP VACCINE REQUIREMENT FOR ALL 7th GRADE STUDENTS:

Per SC law, all students entering 7th grade require an updated TDAP vaccine. CCSD Nursing services will be doing these vaccinations on site on 7/28 from 3:00pm-6:00pm.
