

Emmett School District Superintendent's Report May 12, 2025

District Updates

- Emmett School District is preparing the 2025-2026 budget with no supplemental levy funds.
 - 2009-2025 Supplemental Levy
 - Peak Cost Per 100K
 - 1999 \$387 per 100K
 - 2024 Cost Per 100K
 - 2024 \$3.34 per 100K "Tort Levy Only"
 - <u>Tax History Emmett School District</u>
- Current Vacancies
 - District-wide includes retirees and some changes in positions
 - Athletics at EHS vacancies are higher than in the past
 - Multiple applications for most positions across the district
 - Hard to fill SPED or Mathematics have fewer applicants

District Academics

- K-12 Emmett Remote Academia 2025-26 Director of Online Learning Richard Winegar
- Online Academy will utilize Edmentum and Calvert Academy for K-6, BYU Online, and IDLA for 7-12
 - Continue to work with the College of Western Idaho to provide Early Entry College Pathways for both our Online students and face-to-face at both EHS and True North Prep

- o ISAT Testing in ELA, Math, and Science window is currently open
 - Testing Window Closes May 23, 2025
 - Preliminary test scores will be available by Jun 1, 2025, with finalized scores in mid-summer
 - IRI testing K-3 reading is currently being completed.

Maintenance and Facility Updates

- Wright Brothers is still working on the design plan of the EMS HVAC system
 - ESD team to tour the facility with the proposed system
 - Mr. Hyde, Mr. Rountree, and an EMS staff member will tour a facility in Denver, Colorado, with Wright Brothers
 - Continued work on the EHS football field, and some concerns are still under warranty
 - EHS outdoor restrooms are located at the EHS football field. Remodel and upgrade of restrooms for PE classes while outside and during events.
 - EHS Baseball Field Pressbox
 - Pressbox will be updated and finished in school colors and completed over the summer
 - Black Canyon Future Site
 - A possible location would be to relocate the school using school district portables and moving the complex into the playground field east of Butte View Elementary



- Butte View Elementary Gymnasium
 - Depending on the cost and funds from HB 521 for a possible stand-alone gymnasium at Butte View for K-5 Elementary use
- Planning for removing and replacing the High School parking lot asphalt for the early summer of 2026, depending on funding availability.
- Emmett School District and Payette River Technical Academy Service Agreement
 - Emmett School District continues to meet with PRTA regarding the current service agreement and billing terms, as well as future service agreement billing
 - Currently working on a non-compete addendum for the PRTA Charter that provides stability in courses for both PRTA and EHS.
