Spring State and Benchmark Testing



State & Benchmark test data is used for many purposes.

Multiple sources of data are used to analyze school wide trends at grade and classroom levels, as well as individual student proficiency and growth of grade level standards.

State Tests:

K - 3rd students - I.R.I. (Idaho Reading Indicator) Istation tests begin week of May 12th 3rd - 5th students - ISAT ELA & Math tests began last week of April

5th - ISAT Science test

Benchmark Tests:

4th & 5th - Istation Reading begin week of May 12th

K - 5th - Istation Math

2nd - 5th - IXL ELA & Math

2024-25 we embraced the challenge to improve and show growth using benchmark data as a tool to inform instruction, professional learning, and support student needs. We are encouraged by the overall growth K - 3 students have demonstrated in monthly Istation testing and look forward to Spring Benchmark results.

Preliminary ISAT Results:

Math scores show improvement in each grade level.

3rd grade = **57% proficiency** above the state average of 50% proficiency and higher than previous 3 years. We are encouraged by the preliminary ELA results so far!
