


Special Education Monthly Board Report Emmett School District May 2025

Special Education Demographics:

As of May 7, 2025, the home page of our IEP platform (Edplan) shows 359 (up from 358 in April students receiving Special Education, with an additional 13 Consents for Evaluation, and two referrals.
