


Special Education Monthly Board Report Emmett School District June 2025

2025 IDAA (Idaho Alternative Assessment) State Reviewer Feedback – Emmett School District

The Emmett School District received exemplary ratings from the Idaho State Department of Education regarding its 2025 Idaho Alternate Assessment (IDAA) administration. Observers noted that the testing environment, staff preparation, and student support reflected best practices and high standards of integrity.

Strengths Highlighted:

- Strong procedures for training, security, and accommodations.
- Clear collaboration between the DTC and the Special Education Director.

- Secure materials are stored and handled according to protocol.

Results:

- No concerns were identified.
- Emmett's administration is considered a model for the IDAA.
- No additional monitoring is required by the state.
