Your Guide to Applying to Community College or Trade School



1. Research schools and programs

- a.Most Community Colleges and Trade Schools don't have hard and fast deadlines like a lot of four-year schools.
- b.Be sure to look at the websites for any deadlines that they might have.

2. Prepare all application materials

- a. Typically you will need your high school transcript and personal information, such as your social security number.
- b.If you were born in the US, you are not a "Legal Resident" but a "US Citizen"

3. Submit your applications

a. Some Community Colleges will not send an "Acceptance" Letter. They will typically accept anyone who wants to take classes.

4. Apply for financial aid

a. The FAFSA opens in December and in order to qualify for Financial Aid you will need to complete this.

5. Follow up on application status

- a.Make sure that you set up your account. If you plan to take summer or fall classes, you should hear from the college by midlate April to set up your class schedule.
- b.Don't hesitate to reach out to the college to answer any and all questions that you have.
