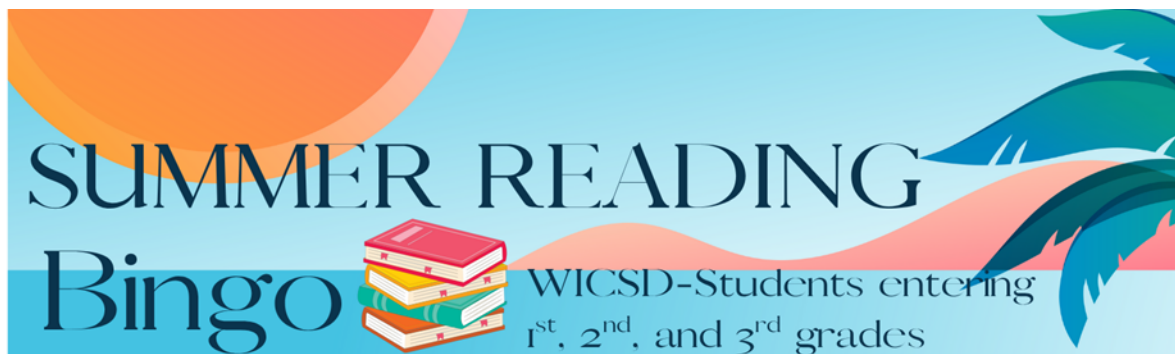

## Free Ebooks and Audiobooks!

Download the Sora app to your personal device.

Click on: **Find Your School**

Click on: **Yes, use my location**

Let's find your school: Type in **Brookview Elementary**

Matching schools: Click on **WICSD – Brookview Elementary**

Select **West Irondequoit Central Schools** from the next drop-down menu

Type in your school username and password (same as your school computer login)

Once in the program, you may search for a title or browse titles that come up.

When you find a book that you want to read, you may check it out by clicking on the book.

Then, click **Borrow** (under the picture of the book cover). The book will be loaned to you and become part of your account for a few weeks. Once the loan time is up, the book will automatically be returned. If you are done early, please click on **Return**. If you need more time, you may **Renew** the title!

When you click out of the book you should see the bottom display bar showing the navigation tools:

**Home (house icon) \* Explore (binocular icon) \* Shelf (books) \* Me (emoji)**

Remember to visit the Home and Explore icons often since both pages highlight books and offer suggestions to select.

### **KEEP IN MIND:**

-If a book is already checked out, you may place a hold on the book by clicking on "Place Hold."

-If the selection is an audiobook, there will be an icon of headphones under the picture of the book cover.

-You may also access books from the public library with your public library card! You can add this to your account by going to the 3 lines icon in the top right corner and clicking on "Add a Library." Next, search for your public library!
