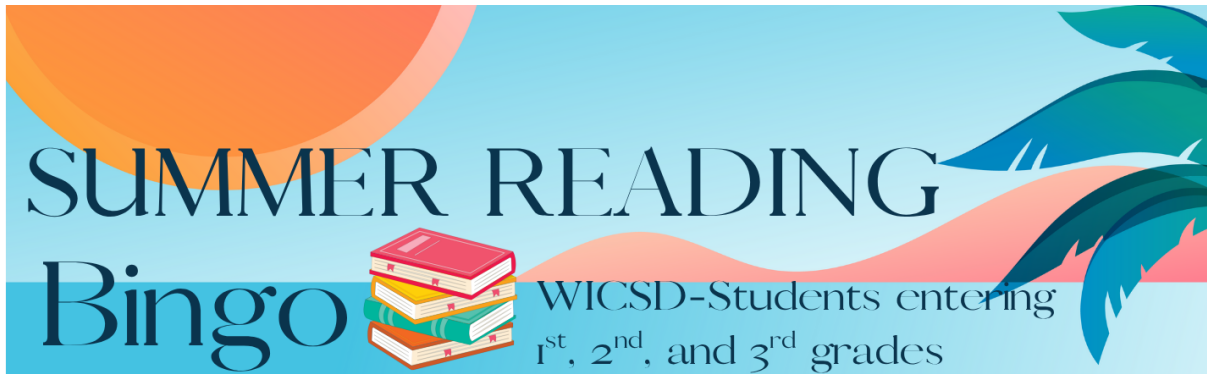

## Free Ebooks and Audiobooks!

### Download Sora app to your personal device

In Google, type in “Sora” and then click on the first link (soraapp.com)

Click on Find My School

Click on Yes, use my location

If Southlawn Elementary School does not come up, click on My school isn't listed

Type in Southlawn Elementary School (be sure to click on the one that says Monroe #1 BOCES!)

Select West Irondequoit Central Schools from the dropdown menu

Type in your school username and password (same for computer login)

When in, you can search for title or browse titles that come up

When you find the book you want to read, you will check it out by clicking on it.

Then click Borrow (under picture of book cover). It then becomes part of your account. When you click out of the book you should see the bottom display bar shows: Home (house icon) \* Explore (binocular icon) \* Shelf (books) \* Me (emoji)

You will have a certain amount of time to borrow the book. Once the time is up it will be automatically returned. If you are done early, please click on Return. If you need more time, you can renew!

### **KEEP IN MIND:**

-If a book is already checked out, you can place a hold by clicking on “Place Holds”

-If it is an audiobook, there will be an icon of headphones on the bottom of the cover picture

-You can also access books from the Public Library with your Public Library Card! You can add this to your account by going to the 3 lines icon and clicking on “Add a Library” and searching for your public library!
