The expansion introduces a new grade level to the TK program, welcoming children as young as 3 years and 11 months. With this full-day program, students are immersed in a supportive, engaging environment that builds a strong foundation for lifelong learning.

“This expansion isn’t just about classrooms and facilities; it’s about opening doors to a brighter future for our students,” said Principal Colette Burgess. “We are fostering a love for learning from the very start, and I’m grateful to everyone who made this vision possible for our children and community.”
