About Us



We are a group of volunteers through MACCI's Leadership Marshfield class of 2025, looking to support a new all-inclusive playground at Griese Park,

The existing playground at Griese was built in 2001 as a Leadership project and is mostly wooden structures that are reaching the end of their very well-loved life; some of the structures have become unsafe and are set to be phased out by the City over the next year or so.

We have begun to fundraise with a goal of \$750k to renovate the playground by constructing a brand new all-inclusive playground at another larger site at Griese, more central to the soccer fields. Site prep will begin this fall with playground construction in 2026.

We have set up an account with the Marshfield Area Community Foundation Inc. where tax exempt donations can be made.
