Attendance is Mandatory

The summer semester consists of 24 instructional days and 2 examination days Eastern Suffolk BOCES requires that attendance be in accordance with the policy set at each individual site.

Class participation is factored into a student's summer school grade. Poor attendance coupled with the lack of class participation or completion of assigned work may result in a student not earning a passing grade for the class. More than three (3) unexcused absences will likely result in a student being unable to earn sufficient points to pass the class.

- Lateness, 5 to 15 minutes, counts as half an absence.
- Lateness of more than 15 minutes counts as a full absence.
- The actual granting of credit must be made by the student's home school.

Student Regulations

- Smoking/vaping is prohibited anywhere in the school building or on school grounds.
- Clothing must be school appropriate and not distract from or interfere with teaching and learning. Undergarments must covered at all times.
- Parking is permitted in designated areas only. Junior license operators are not permitted to drive to summer school.
- Students will be dismissed from the program for inappropriate behavior.
- Use of cell phones, pagers, and any other type of electronic devices will be strictly prohibited during summer school hours.

Support Services

Individual IEPs/504 Plans must be provided by parent/person of parental relation during summer school registration. Students who experience course difficulties are encouraged to confer with teachers and the principal as soon as possible.

Transportation

Transportation to and from summer school is not provided by Eastern Suffolk BOCES.

Tuition Payments

- Payment must be made by credit card, money order or certified check payable to Bay Shore UFSD.
- Cash or personal checks will not be accepted.
- Classes/program offering is dependent on enrollment.
- NO REFUNDS will be made for any reason, other than cancellation due to insufficient registration.

NOTE: Students taking the Regents are encouraged to take the Regents Review course. Experience shows a much higher percentage of students pass the exams when they take the course.

Instruction is designed to provide opportunities for students to succeed with previously attempted course work. A report card will be sent home to each student.

Due to confidentiality, grades will not be given over the phone.
