## Smoking / Vaping

- New York State Law prohibits smoking / vaping in any public school or on school grounds.
- A zero tolerance policy will be enforced regarding smoking / vaping on school property.
- There are no exceptions to this policy.
- Any student who violates these rules/regulations will be dropped from the summer school program.

## Attendance

- Class Participation is an integral part of your ability to gain credit
- Each student will be expected to have no more than three absences from each class.
- These absences should be used sparingly.
- There are no "excused absences" such as illness, previously scheduled vacations, sporting events, camps, court appearances or doctor's appointments.
- Class participation is an integral part of your ability to gain credit in summer school and you cannot satisfy your class participation requirements if you are absent more than three times.
- You must attend a minimum of 27 of the 30 days of actual instruction to be eligible for credit. Your ability to gain credit will be eliminated if you exceed your limit.
- It is our firm belief that time on task is a very important part of success in school.
- We believe that there is a direct relationship between class participation and academic success. For this reason, good attendance is consistent with all positive educational goals and class participation is factored into the grade.

## **Emergency Contact Card**

- The Summer School Nurse must have an emergency contact card on file for each student.
- Your teacher will distribute an emergency contact card on the first day of class.
- These cards must be returned to your teacher on or before July 17 2025.

## **Final Examinations**

- A final examination, will be given in all classes.
- If a final exam is given, a student who does not take this examination may receive an exam grade of zero.
- Final Exam grades will be printed on report cards.

# Fire Drills

- The building must be evacuated at the sound of the fire alarm.
- At the sound of the fire alarm you are to proceed to the nearest exit in accordance with your teacher's instructions.
- If you are leaving from an exit in the front of the building, you are to proceed to the parking lot and stay with your class so that your teacher is able to take attendance.

## **Gang Prevention**

## Grades

- There are two report card marking periods.
- The passing grade is 65.
- The first marking period grade will be assigned on Thursday, July 31, 2025
- The second marking period grade will be assigned on Monday, August 18, 2025
- The final grade for the course is mostly based on an average of the grades for the two marking periods and the final exam.
- Final exams *may* count as 1/5 of the total grade. Those who did not take this examination *could* receive a grade of zero for the final exam.
- Class participation points are necessary to gain credit for a course.

# Hats

# Lateness to Class

• Students who arrive late to class must first report to the late hall for a pass. Three latenesses equal one absence.

# Parking

- Only licensed drivers attending summer school may park in the school parking lot.
- All parking is subject to the availability of space and observance of traffic regulations and instructions of School Security Officers.
- Parking is at your own risk.

# Fees and Tuition

• There is no registration fee.

# Sexual Harassment

- No students or employees should be subject to offensive behavior stemming from actions or inappropriate remarks meant to attack people's race, color, creed, religion, national origin, sex, disability, age, or status regarding public assistance.
