**Description of Unpaid/Unfinished Bonds Previously Approved by Voters of the Jurisdiction:**

As of the 9th day of September, 2025, Independent School District No. 72, Bryan County, Oklahoma, has 2 General Obligation bond issue(s) outstanding:

- \$4,050,000 Combined Purpose Bonds of 2024, dated May 1, 2024 (\$4,050,000 outstanding in principal as of the 9th day of September, 2025); and
- \$4,110,000 Combined Purpose Bonds of 2025, dated June 1, 2025 (\$4,110,000 outstanding in principal as of the 9th day of September, 2025).

The School District has \$27,855,000 in unissued building bonds authorized at an election held on the 10th day of September, 2019. These bonds will be used to complete the constructing, furnishing, equipping and/or acquiring of the new elementary school with safe room; acquiring and/or installing technology equipment, instructional software and textbooks; acquiring band/orchestra equipment; acquiring choir/fine arts equipment; acquire drama/debate program equipment; repair and/or replace roofs and HVAC equipment; renovating, repairing, and/or remodeling existing school sites and acquiring equipment; and acquiring maintenance equipment. The School District has \$300,000 in unissued transportation equipment bonds authorized at an election held on the 10th day of September, 2019. These bonds will be used to acquire vehicles for pupil transportation.
