1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

During the 2024–25 school year, the Oroville Union High School District (OUHSD) used Arts and Music in Schools (Prop 28) funding to expand access to visual and performing arts instruction. Building on the stakeholder-driven planning that took place in 2023–24, the district added new course sections in Ceramics and Theater at Las Plumas High School, Oroville High School, and Prospect High School. To further support program growth, OUHSD is in the process of hiring a teacher for the Arts, Media, and Entertainment (AME) pathway. The district is also recruiting paraeducators to assist with instruction across its Visual and Performing Arts (VAPA) programs, providing increased student support and enhancing learning environments. Prop 28 funds were also used to purchase new and upgraded supplies and equipment for VAPA classrooms. These materials support high-quality instruction and allow for greater student engagement across a range of artistic disciplines. Through these investments, OUHSD is advancing its goal of providing equitable access to arts education and expanding creative opportunities for all students.
