


For the 2025-2026 Academic Year in College

- 3. Applications reviewed for eligibility and compliance with instructions.
- 4. Applicants notified of their status.
- 5. Finalists provide supplemental information.
 - 6. Scholarships awarded in April, 2025.

- 1. Must attend a high school located in the U.S.
- 2. Eligible high schools include public, private, charter, magnet, and STEM schools.
- 3. Applicants who are not U.S. Citizens must be fluent in the English language.
 - 4. Must be in the high school graduating class.
- 5. Must have a 3.50 cumulative grade point average.
- 6. Must enroll in an eligible four-year or higher college or university following high school graduation.
 - 7. Must maintain a four year or less graduation schedule in college.


