

CONGRATULATIONS CLASS OF 2025!





PROGRAM RECOGNITIONS

MATH/SCIENCE/COMPUTER (MSC) **PROGRAM GRADUATES**



The Livonia Math/Science/Computer (MSC) Program was founded in 1984 and is housed at Churchill High School. MSC is celebrating the conclusion of its 41st year. MSC graduates have completed a minimum of 23 semesters of coursework in mathematics, science, and computer science. The foundation of the MSC curriculum is the College Board Advanced Placement exams. Students apply for the MSC program during the fall of their 8th grade year, and selection is based on academic test scores, student essays, and teacher recommendations. The MSC program is open to students from all three LPS high school attendance areas. This year's MSC graduates were collectively awarded \$4.9 million in scholarships.




