- Apply for Scholarships.
- Demonstrate Trust, Respect and Responsibility in my interactions with all staff members and peers.

As a parent/guardian, I will:

- Ensure that my child attends school daily and arrives on time.
- Encourage my child to stay in school and prepare for graduation and post secondary options such as college or workforce.
- Know what my child should learn and know at grade level and how I, as a parent/guardian can help my child learn. .
- Explore college/workforce ready options with my child and my child's counselor.
- Balance my child's TV and video game playing time with learning opportunities such as reading 20 to 30 minutes daily and/ or going to the library. Have conversations about proper cell phone use.
- Attend parent conferences, PTSO meetings, and parent education workshops. .

- Create a learning environment where students feel safe, respected, and nurtured in order for healthy student-to-student relations and healthy student to teacher relationships can exist.
- Show respect for all parents, students, community, and colleagues.
- Communicate and problem solve with students, parents and colleagues, in order to foster student development and learning.
- Expect and challenge all students to learn a rigorous, high level of thinking and learning with real world applications.
- Seek resources and assistance for a child who is struggling with learning or having difficulty in school.
- Enforce all the Dallas ISD, campus, and classroom policies on a fair and consistent basis.
- Provide two-way communication with parent/guardian regularly on ways to help a child learn.
- Communicate with parent/guardian and child "what" students should learn and know at each grade level and "how" to engage parents about the child's education.

As a Principal, I will:

- Seek input from all stakeholders regarding school operations and learning goals as outlined in the campus improvement plan.

- Provide Staff Development opportunities that are research based to support campus needs.
- Communicate with the parents/guardians regularly regarding student achievement, college/and career readiness. Provide parent/guardians educational information and workshops on strategies to support student academic success and high school graduation.
- Partner with community based and government organizations to provide support for students and families.
