



CISD BOARD REPORT

A Summary of the Board of Trustees Meeting

June 16, 2025

The Board of Trustees of the Corsicana Independent School District met in a Board Meeting at 5:30 p.m. on Monday, June 16, 2025 at the Corsicana ISD Dr. Kent Rogers Administration Building, 2200 W. 4th Ave., Corsicana, Texas. The meeting was called to order by Brad Farmer, President of the Board of Trustees.

Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 PM by Board President Brad Farmer. A Quorum was determined.

Audience for Guests

There were no guest speakers.

Facility Committee Recommendation

Jourdan Harrelson, Misty Coles, Terry Garner, Andy Williams and Annot Walthall represented the Facility Committee. Mrs. Harrelson began the presentation by explaining the process the committee has been working on since February 2025. The Facility Committee is recommending that CISD go out for a bond in the November 2025 election. The bond would be for \$205,000,00 and would include the following upgrades to our campuses.

- New Early Childhood Center (800 students)
- High School CTE Addition
- High School Kitchen/Cafeteria Expansion
- High School Bathroom Upgrades
- High School Classroom Renovations
- New Agricultural Facility
- New Transportation Building
- Collins Improvements
- Bowie Restroom Upgrades
- Buses (15)
- Bowie Structural Repairs
- Fannin Structural Repairs
- HVAC & Roof Repair/Replacement
- Security Upgrades – Badge Reader Entry System

This recommendation will be brought back to the Board in August 2025 for consideration.

2024-2025 Quarterly Budget Update

Sean Kays gave the Board an update on current budget status of the 2024-2025 Budget.

2025-2026 Budget Update

Sean Kays gave a preliminary review and projected expense summary of the upcoming budget for the 2025-2026 school year. It is projected that the district will start the 2025-2026 school with at 3.3 – 3.9 million dollar deficit.

Collins Scholarship Update – Jarod Gordon and Kasey Fagan

Jarod Gordon and Kasey Fagan, Community National Bank and Trust gave an in depth update of the Collins Scholarship holdings.

Child Nutrition Update

Child Nutrition Director, Kim Prowell gave an overview of meals and food served by the department in the 2024-2025 school year. There were 1,341,759 meals served.

Bank Bid Depository

On a motion by Cathy Branch and seconded by Jamie Roman, the Board of Trustees voted to approve Vera Bank as CISD's bank depository institution from September 01, 2025 to August 31, 2027.

The motion passed unanimously.
