

EPHRATA SCHOOL DISTRICT K-6 DRESS CODE

Students must be dressed in a neat and clean manner. Appearance shall not be disruptive to the educational process. A student wearing disruptive clothing will be referred to an administrator. (District Policy 3224)



NOTE: Clothing must cover the body, as described while a student is sitting, standing, bending or reaching.

Head

Hoods must be removed in the building.

Torso

Clothing must cover the stomach, back, shoulders, chest and undergarments. See-through clothing is not allowed.

Legs

Pants, shorts, skirts and dresses cannot be see-through. All undergarments must be covered by shorts, skirts & dresses. Holes in clothing must also be clearly below a student's longest finger as they stand with their shoulders relaxed and arms at their sides.

Feet

Footwear must be worn at all time and be appropriate for the student's activity. Footwear must cover the entire foot or have a back-strap to secure the shoe to the foot.

Other Guidelines

- To ensure student safety during inclement weather, students must wear clothing that fully covers their legs during the second and third quarters of school (approximately November -April). During this time, shorts, skirts and dresses are only permitted if worn with leggings or other leg coverings.
- Any item of clothing or accessory deemed to be a health or safety hazard, or a learning distraction to others, will not be allowed. Trench coats are not allowed. Chains are not allowed.

- Students are not allowed to wear any gang-related items. See District Policy #3224)
- Clothing and/or accessories displaying or making reference to alcohol, illicit drugs, tobacco or clothing displaying profane, vulgar, discriminatory or sexual language or pictures shall not be worn.
- No sunglasses, hoods or bandanas (not including hair bands worn in building)
