







## **2023 CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS**

- Total Construction dollar value of \$76,735,898.37




## **2024 CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS**

## **2025 CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS**


- **32** Individual active projects with a construction value greater than \$150,000

## CAPITAL PROJECTS (CPP)

#### Projects that are considered capital in nature:

- Site acquisition and development
- Building construction, replacement, renovation, remodeling, improvement
- To repair and replace buildings and building fixtures
- Construction, repair, replacement, remodeling or maintenance of a school sports facility
  - Budget limited to 2.7% of the Operations Fund property tax revenue



## **2025 CAPITAL PROJECTS**


#### Facilities Projects/Budget Includes:

- Construction & Renovation
- School Sports Facilities
- Mobile or Fixed Equipment (Furnishings)
- Professional Services
- Land Acquisition
- Emergency Allocation

15% of the work has been completed.

91% of the work has been awarded.

Remaining budget consists of equipment/ furnishings purchases and allowances for land purchase and emergency projects.






## **2020 REPAIR PROGRAM**

- 83.2% of the work has been awarded.
- The final bond needed to complete the funding (\$21.7M) will be issued later this year.




