Q: Can I bring my child(ren) with me to class?

A: No. Children are NOT allowed to attend class with parents. This applies to in-person and virtual classes if offered. English Learner (EL) class events and field trips are sometimes an exception.

Q: Can I bring my child(ren) with me to pre-test or posttest?

A: No. Children are NEVER allowed to attend the progress testing with parents.

Q: How long does it take to learn English?

A: Learning a language can take years, but we require you to commit to completing at least 60 hours in order to show progress with our EL program.

Q: I signed up for class but now I am moving OR I have a new job. What can I do?

A: Please contact an instructor immediately so we can find solutions for you to fulfill your student requirements.

Q: What if the class is too difficult for me?

A: Continue attending class even when it's difficult! We work very hard to meet the needs of all students, but language learning takes persistence and effort on the part of the student.

Q: Do I need a Social Security Number (SSN)?

A: A Social Security Number is not required to sign up for our program. When you obtain your SSN, please tell your instructor so we can update our records.

Q: Where do I enroll and test?

A: Enrollment and progress testing are in-person ONLY at GFCMSU, CCRC G30, 2100 16th Ave. S. Great Falls, MT.

Q: Where are the EL classes held?

A: EL classes meet at GFCMSU, 2100 16th Avenue South, Great Falls, MT. Actual classrooms will vary based on your needs and interests.

Q: When are classes?

A: Currently we offer face-to-face EL instruction Monday – Thursday, 8:30am-3:30pm. EL class schedules will be based on pre-assessment scores.

Q: Do you have EL classes in the evenings or via Zoom?

A: EL class times are established each year to meet the needs of as many students as possible.
