Shirts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Green or yellow polo style shirts • College/Badger shirts • Shirts may not extend below fingertips 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No oversized shirts- Polos or T-shirts • No crop tops • No logos
Pants/Slacks/ Shorts/Skirts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Solid Denim jeans, khaki's, grey, blue and black jeans may be worn • All pants/shorts must fit appropriately and adequately at the waist and crotch. • Pants that have holes/rips must be at knee level or below. Rips/holes above the knee must be covered. • Joggers and warmup bottoms are allowed. Joggers and warmups must fit appropriately and adequately at the waist and be of a solid color (no prints or designs) • Shorts, skirts and dresses are allowed. Shorts, skirts and dresses must be an appropriate length. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No baggy pants/jeans/shorts • No tights, leggings or pajamas • No hats/caps/beanies allowed in the cafeteria, classroom or hallways • No oversized coats/clothing • No trench coats • No pajama bottoms or bottoms that look like pajamas

This includes but is not limited to: documented insignias, symbols, color combinations of clothing, hair styles/cuts, No pocket bandana flags 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No baggy pants/ jeans or oversized shirts No shorts with knee high socks Pants worn low or "sagging" and cuffed inside on the bottom are prohibited
