The Southampton Transfer Station reserves the right to charge appropriately for any load(s) of excessive quantity or reject any load(s) found to be in violation of the Waste Ban Plan for Southampton and/or applicable State or Federal regulations. Video/photo surveillance may be in use. Violation of Transfer Station rules is grounds for ejection from Transfer Station and invalidation of Transfer Station permit.

The Southampton Transfer Station accepts the following materials at NO CHARGE for valid permit holders:

Paper and Cardboard

- ✓ All paper and cardboard should be dry
- ✓ Junk mail – Plastic windows are okay
- ✓ Paperboard – Cereal boxes, shoe boxes, cracker boxes, clean pizza boxes, etc. Remove plastic liners.
- ✓ Pizza boxes – empty: no food, wax paper liners, etc.
- ✓ Newspapers/inserts
- ✓ Magazines/catalogs
- ✓ Paper bags
- ✓ White and colored office paper
- ✓ Corrugated cardboard – Flatten when possible. Do not tie with string.
- ✓ Paperbacks and phone books -covers okay

Comingled Recyclable Containers

- ✓ Remember to rinse containers before recycling.
- ✓ Glass bottles/jars, less than 2.5 gallons – Labels, lids, neck rings, etc. are okay
- ✓ Aluminum, tin/steel cans and lids, and aluminum foil – Labels are okay
- ✓ Milk & juice cartons (tent top), drink boxes – Remove straws
- ✓ Plastic bottles/jars/jugs/tubs. Empty, rinse, and place cap back on the container. No loose caps or lids.
- ✓ Clear plastic hinged containers (clamshells). No clamshells that are black plastic, Styrofoam or compostable.
- ✓ Clear plastic egg cartons, clear plastic cups (crystal clear, printing OK) – place straws and lids in the trash.

- × NO TANGLERS (hoses, cords, Christmas lights, plastic wrap, rope, twine, *et cetera*)
- × No light bulbs, window or auto glass, dishes, glasses, Pyrex, ceramics.
- × No paint cans.
- × No household metal objects – there is a separate metal dumpster for these.
- × No clothing or textiles – there is a separate bin for clothing and textiles.
- × No plastic bags, containers over 2.5 gallons, motor oil jugs, chemical or Styrofoam containers or flowerpots.

Organic yard waste

- ✓ Leaves, twigs, grass clippings, weeds, coffee grounds.
- ✓ Food scraps are okay except meat and dairy.

- × NO BRANCHES/WOOD GREATER THAN 1" DIAMETER.
- × NO DOG OR CAT WASTE.
- × No plastics or other non-compostable contaminants.

We also accept the following items:

- ✓ UNBROKEN Fluorescent light tubes and Compact Fluorescent light bulbs.
- ✓ UNBROKEN Mercury-containing devices (thermometers, thermostats, ballasts).
- ✓ Lead Batteries (automotive batteries).
- ✓ Lithium Batteries (button batteries, cell phone batteries, computer batteries, uninterrupted power supplies, rechargeable device batteries, *et cetera*).
- ✓ Oil (less than 5 Gallons)
- ✓ Small metal items.
- ✓ Usable items may be placed in the FREE-cycling shed (swap shop) **at the discretion of the Attendant.** No infant items (toys, car seats, high chairs, cribs) accepted. **Do not place anything in the shed without first confirming with the Attendant.**
- ✓ Textiles/clothing.
- ✓ Books.
