# New to FBCA Students and Incoming 5th graders

The Eagle Way orientation will take place from 9:00AM to 11:30AM in the Cafetorium. We ask that at least one parent is present with their student as parents will obtain vital information during this time to ensure their students' success.

Everyone will be released from the Cafetorium to head upstairs to the Middle School floor to complete New Student Orientation.

# **Returning Students**

Returning students are welcome to come <u>anytime between 1:30pm - 3:00pm</u> to pick up their schedules, locker assignments, and technology.

#### **Arrival/Dismissal Procedures**

Maps to help with traffic flow will be provided in the July newsletter and in the Back-to-School packet.

#### **Morning Drop-off**

To help with the flow of traffic for FBCA, parents will turn right on Lakeview from Gillingham from the direction of Jess Pirtle.

Left turns from Lakeview to enter the parking lot are prohibited during morning and afternoon carpool times.

In an effort to help with the traffic flow for nearby businesses, we ask that you do not use Schlumberger's parking lot and driveway as a turnaround or waiting point to get in the FBCA carline.

# Families are to approach our campus for morning and afternoon carline as follows:

- Take Highway 90 to Eldridge
- Head north on Eldridge to Jess Pirtle
- Turn right on Jess Pirtle
- Turn right on Gillingham
- Turn right on Lakeview until you reach our parking lot

\*After you drop off your student(s), we ask that you *turn right* out of the LS/MS parking lot to avoid traffic congestion. Left turns on Lakeview to enter the Lower School/Middle School parking lot are prohibited unless you are a staff member with the correct identifying tag.

- Enter the parking lot and circle around to form one line.
- For the safety of students, do not allow children to exit vehicles from the left side of your vehicle.
- In order for traffic to flow continuously and so that others are not kept waiting, please have backpacks ready to unload!
- Your child will enter the LS/MS gym until dismissed to head upstairs, unless they are attending office hours at 7:45 a.m.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Children dropped off prior to 7:30 a.m. must be escorted by a parent into Morning Care. Regular Extended Care charges will be applied to your child's tuition account.

# **After School Pick-up**

The afternoon pick up has been modified based on the rotating schedule and later release time. Each family will be provided two car tags with your student(s)' name(s) on them at back to school check in.

All other details for pick up procedures will be outlined in our July newsletter along with maps that will show the traffic flow.
