Back-to-School Fair - This will be from 1:00 - 4:00 pm in the LS/MS Gym, Cafetorium, etc. It is a fun come-and-go event! You will be able to pick up spirit store gear (if it was purchased before July 9, 2025; orders purchased after July 9 will ship to your home), Taher will have food samples, and you can enjoy a Kona Ice. The following

booths will be available in the LS/MS Gym for you to stop by to ask questions: School Nurse, Taher, Extended Care, PTF, Booster Club, Athletics, and Fine Arts.

New Student/Parent Orientation - 2:00 - 2:30 pm in the LS/MS Cafetorium - New families will be able to meet other new Eagle families, connect with our admin team, learn about Blackbaud, lunch accounts, and Lower School procedures. We'd love for you to join us for Popcorn with the Principals at 2:30 pm immediately following. We hope to see you there!

Meet the Teacher - 3:00 - 5:00 pm - Each student will receive a back-to-school packet that will consist of carline procedures and carline tags, chapel schedule, lunch menu, nurse information, Extended Care details, etc.

- Class lists will be posted outside the classrooms at 3:00 pm.
- PK/K Parents: Please bring the 1-inch nap mat, so students don't have to carry it on the first day of school.

→ Arrival/Dismissal Procedures

Maps to help with traffic flow will be provided in the July newsletter and in the Back-to-School packet that you will pick up in your child's classroom on Monday, August 11 at the Meet the Teacher from 3:00 - 5:00 pm.

To help with the flow of traffic for FBCA, we encourage parents to turn right on Lakeview from Gillingham from the direction of Jess Pirtle. Also, left turns from Lakeview to enter the parking lot are prohibited during morning and afternoon carpool times.

We are asking families to approach our campus for morning and afternoon carline as follows:

- Take Highway 90 to Eldridge
- Head north on Eldridge to Jess Pirtle
- Turn right on Jess Pirtle
- Turn right on Gillingham
- Turn right on Lakeview until you reach our parking lot

Also, in an effort to help with the traffic flow for nearby businesses, we ask that you do not use Schlumberger's parking lot and driveway as a turnaround or waiting point to get in the FBCA carline.

*After you drop off your student(s), we ask that you **turn right** out of the LS/MS parking lot to avoid traffic congestion. Left turns on Lakeview to enter the Lower School/Middle School parking lot are prohibited.

→ Morning Drop-off

- Morning drop-off for Lower School begins at 7:30 a.m.
- Enter the parking lot and circle around to form one line.
- On-duty staff members, Dads on Duty, and CIA (Courtesy-In-Action) students will assist your child(ren) in exiting your car.
- For the safety of students, do not allow children to exit vehicles unassisted or to exit from the left side of your vehicle.
- Please wait for a staff member to open the door of your vehicle.
- In order for traffic to flow continuously and so that others are not kept waiting,
 please have backpacks ready to unload and kisses and hugs already given!
- Your child will be escorted into the building and attended in the LS/MS gym until our staff is dismissed from morning devotion at 7:50 a.m.

PLEASE NOTE: Children dropped off prior to 7:30 a.m. must be escorted by a parent into Morning Care. Regular Extended Care charges will be applied to your child's tuition account.

→ After School Pick-up

Maps to help with traffic flow will be provided in the July newsletter and in the Back-to-School packet that you will pick up in your child's classroom on Monday, August 11 at the Meet the Teacher from 3:00 - 5:00 pm. The afternoon pick up has been modified based on the middle school rotating schedule and new dismissal time for Pre-K and Kindergarten.
