



# Grace High School - Four-Year Plan

Full-time students in 9th-11th grades enroll in a total of 7 courses each year. 12th-grade students may enroll in a minimum of 6 classes provided they have met all graduation requirements and have a cumulative GPA of 2.6 or higher at the start of their senior year. In each subject area, students may select one of the listed classes. Electives will fill up the remaining courses.
