While being screen-based, iReady can help you assist your child in summer independent reading application and selection of IXL activities. Log-in information is the same as during the school year; students should log-into their SBS Google accounts and access the platforms via Clever. If you don't know your child's Google login please ask your child's homeroom teacher.

While all students in grades 5 through 8 are required to complete mandatory summer reading and math assignments, our K through 4 teachers have put together suggested work for students entering kindergarten through grade 4. One doesn't need to look further than the decades-long research on the <u>Summer Slide</u> in Mathematics and Reading to see the importance of keeping up with math and reading skills during the long Summer Break.
