WELCOME TO UNIFIED ARTS!

***Not all students will be taking the following classes. Please refer to your student's schedule before acquiring the items below.**

ART

- 1 9 x 12 sketchbook (recommended but not required)
- 1 Box of #2 pencils
- 1 Box of 12-24 colored pencils (may be shared with Science)

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

- 1 PHYSICAL EDUCATION uniform: comfortable clothes to move around & shoes with laces or straps

VOCAL MUSIC

- 1 pencil everyday
- 1 1-inch solid black binder (will get marked with student's name and kept in the choir room)

SPANISH

- 1 two-pocket folder (WITH prongs)
- 1 Notebook

STEM

- Last names A-H- one box of tissues for classroom use
- Last names I-O- one box of resealable baggies (snack, sandwich, or gallon) for classroom use
- Last names P-Z- one box of pencils for classroom use

AVID
