What is new at FRES?

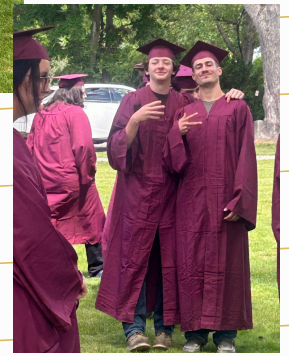

4<sup>th</sup> Grade Field Trip Historical Tour of Lyndeborough & Wilton



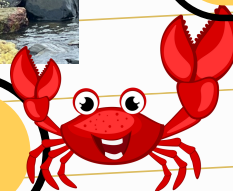
Money raised from the plant sale was used to purchase educational games for all the classrooms and recess carts!

# Special Education

Special Education has been busy this year teaching, testing, and conducting meetings, but the end of the year is finally here. We are looking forward to some relaxation and SUN!

This summer, we will see some of you in our ESY program. Once our list is complete and the case managers meet, you will receive an email from one of us explaining what your child should bring and where to drop off and pick up.

If your child is NOT participating in ESY this summer ( or even if they are), remember to still practice their basic skills to maintain their knowledge. What might this look like? Here are some suggestions:

- Read, Read, Read a book, magazine, or recipe.
- Find a summer book challenge.
- The local library may have activities to participate in.
- Comprehension - Ask your child questions about what they read or about a movie/show they watched. Who? What? Where? When? Why? How?
- Make math flash cards.
- Ask them the time.
- Make a schedule to follow.
- Do they have enough money to buy an item? How much do they need to save?
- Help with doubling a recipe (fractions).
- Write a thank you card or invitation.
- Plan a menu, shop on a budget, and cook the meal.
- Sort laundry by colors.
- Have back-and-forth conversations. Can they stay on topic? Are they listening to the other person?
- Play board games. Can they take turns? Are they good winners/losers?
- Count items, and group by tens or fives.
- Conduct science experiments.
- Create a spelling list.
- Keep a summer journal.
