Academic Opportunities

To ensure that all of our students are college- and career-ready, Conway High offers a wide array of course options on the college preparatory, world language, honors, and advanced placement levels while providing students with a comprehensive high school experience that includes opportunities in the fine arts and athletics, as well as in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM). Students enrolled in our school have the opportunity to participate in various Advanced Placement courses, which include English Literature and Composition, English Language and Composition, Human Geography, Environmental Science, Calculus AB and BC, Government, and US History. Students also have the opportunity to participate in the AVID program while at Conway High School.

Conway High is also proud to be a Cognia-certified STEM school that offers students the ability to use 21st-century skills to solve hands-on, real-world problems. Students focus on STEM learning in all content areas. In addition, students enrolled in our Project Lead the Way Engineering, Computer Science, and Biomedical Science programs earn honors credit and can potentially earn dual-enrollment credit. Students who enroll in Pharmacology Technology, Veterinary Science, and Hospitality and Tourism can earn a national certification that can launch them into a career immediately after graduating from high school. Other Career and Technology Education offerings at Conway High include Health Science, Sports Medicine, and Horticulture/Agricultural Science.
