Schedules/League Meets

A. Schedules

1. Schedules for the following year shall be assigned at the April CVAL meeting, proposed by the first May CVAL meeting, and approved by the last CVAL meeting at the end of May.
2. Once schedules are approved, changes due to unforeseen events must be made by mutual agreement of the respective Athletic Directors.
3. The league will approve the start date for all seasons of sport and include the start dates on the schedules. There cannot be any try-outs or practices held before the start dates.
4. CVAL will follow the CIF Season of Sport Guidelines <http://www.cifcs.org/playoffs/season-of-sport>
5. Forfeiture and Canceled Games: If a game is canceled, it must be made up if standings are affected by outcome.

B. League Meets

1. Responsibility for League meets/tournaments/matches will rotate among member schools. Schools assigned League meets/tournaments/matches are responsible for, but not limited to, the following:
 1. Site
 2. Ordering awards
 3. Officials
 4. Gate
 5. Tickets
 6. Crowd Control
 7. Security
 8. School administrator on site
 9. Public address system
 10. Presentation of awards
 11. Prorating expenses to each school, if necessary.
2. For responsibilities unique to each sport, please consult individual sport guidelines.
3. Each school must provide an administrator at all home contests.

C. Reporting of Scores

1. Each AD is responsible for entering his/her own home game outcomes on the league website. The deadline to enter scores is noon on the Monday following the conclusion of the prior week's games.
2. Failure to do so will result in the forfeiture of the game regardless of the outcome.
3. The CVAL Web Master will assign forfeitures

D. Post-Season Eligibility

1. Teams must compete in a minimum of 2/3 of the season to qualify for post-season.
