

CENTRAL VALLEY ATHLETIC LEAGUE

BYLAWS

SECTION 200

Article I

- 1.0 Central Valley Athletic League Bylaws may be amended at any regular meeting of the league by a majority vote of the eligible voting member schools.

Article II

- 2.0 If forfeiture of a game occurs, all league representatives must be notified.
- 2.1 Each school shall establish its own standards of health and citizenship for participation.

Article III

- 3.0 The president of the CVAL is authorized to interpret the CVAL Constitution and Bylaws. The president will report any official interpretations at subsequent CVAL meetings for the League's review and consideration.
- 3.1 The CVAL shall provide By-Laws for each sport. By-laws may be amended by a majority vote of eligible member schools. Revisions shall be posted online and made available to each CVAL member school.
- 3.2 All scheduled CVAL games/contests will begin as sport schedule dictates with a "grace" period of 15 minutes. A game may begin after the designated start time if both schools mutually agree or there has been:
- a. A transportation problem such as mechanical breakdown or inclement weather delay which delays the arrival of the bus, or any other reasonable excuse such as unavailability of transportation due to an unforeseen and unusual rescheduling requirement by the visiting school.
 - I. This applies only to district transportation. Must be able to provide proof if requested by the league.
 - II. AD must notify opposing AD or championship chairperson immediately
 - b. In those sports where no CIF official is required, the game may be "called" by the home school, which will include the home team CVAL representative or site administrator. The visiting team will forfeit the game unless "a" above applies.
 - c. In those sports which require a CIF official, the official has the jurisdiction to forfeit the game unless "a" above applies
 - d. The same rules apply for championship tournaments as well.
