Coaching Expectations

AT ALL TIMES, COACHES SHOULD:

1. Recognize that the purpose of athletics is to promote the physical, mental, moral, social, and emotional well being of the individual.
2. Remember they are representing their school, communities, leagues, and their teams, not only themselves.
3. Be cognizant of rules and regulations and should adhere to the spirit of the rules at all times.
4. Be professional role models for the school, community, and athletes and display a professional attitude, personal appearance, and deportment.
5. Show courtesy to visiting teams and coaches, as well as to officials.
6. Keep in mind that officials are trained to administer the contests and should be treated with professional courtesy.
7. Maintain control of their athletes and not tolerate abuse of officials, other coaches, or opposing team players.
8. Report scores to their school's Athletic Director or CVAL elected representative.

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
