Below is a list of all of the items your child will need for this school year, in PreK. Kindly label or write your child's name on all objects and folders as well as on all supplies.

**REMINDER:** School begins at 8:20 and ends at 15:00.

**EVERYDAY Your Child Should Bring:**

- ❖ A snack and a lunch - we encourage healthy food - yogurt, fruit, biscuits, pies, cheese pies, etc. and good home cooked meals for lunch or sandwiches. Please think about your child's appetite during the day and be certain that the food that is sent in with your child is what your children enjoy eating.
- ❖ A labeled bottle (not plastic) of fresh water – we have filtered water at school and will refill.
- ❖ A labeled fork and spoon in a container, these will return home each day.
- ❖ A little tea towel or place mat, which will be sent home each day to be replaced with a clean one.
- ❖ A school bag

<p>A <b>snack box, lunch box, small towel</b>: all clearly labeled with your child's name. Ideally, the snack and lunch container could be eco friendly as our school is <b>plastic free</b>. Thermal containers are great for keeping your child's food at the desired temperature. Glass containers are <b>NOT</b> allowed. Both snack and lunch should include healthy food which your child likes and is familiar with eating. If fruit is included it should be peeled and cut from home (stones should be removed and grapes / cherries cut in half).</p>	
<p>A reusable <b>water</b> bottle. Pinewood is a plastic free campus.</p>	



A **school bag** dimensions 27x10x33 cm (these dimensions are suggested, so the bags can fit in the child's cubby).



A large zip lock bag containing one **full change of clothing** (shirt, pants, jumper, socks) and **2 sets of underwear**. This bag will remain at school and will change according to the weather and season.





A long sleeved painting waterproof **apron**.



**Rain gear** for outdoor play. A lightweight and waterproof rain jacket. Rain boots or waterproof shoes to keep their feet dry. The rain gear can be stored at school, and will be sent back home every two weeks to be washed.





A **plastic folder** with elastic.
