Supplies	Photos of items
<p><u>A durable backpack</u> with a side pocket to hold water bottle (to go back and forth every day) that will fit an A4 sized folder, homework books, lunchbox and water bottle. The bag should be able to fit into the school cubby and be no larger than 40 cm in height. Large trolley bags should be avoided as they don't fit.</p>	
<p><u>A snack box, lunch box, small towel:</u> all should be clearly labeled with your child's name. The snack and lunch containers should fit easily into your child's school bag and be ECO FRIENDLY as the school is making a concerted effort to become PLASTIC FREE. Please choose <u>thermal containers</u> as an excellent option for keeping your child's food at the desired temperature; food is not heated up in K classes. Both snack and lunch should include healthy food which your child likes and is familiar with</p>	



<p>eating. If fruit is included it should be peeled and cut from home (stones should be removed and grapes / cherries cut in half).</p>	
<p><u>Water bottle:</u> labeled with your child's name on. The school is going to be a PLASTIC FREE school. Therefore, we would like to encourage you to purchase environmentally friendly water bottles. Glass bottles ARE NOT ALLOWED for safety reasons.</p>	
<p><u>A change of clothing:</u> to include socks, underwear (two pieces), top and bottom clothing incase of accidents / spillages / sweating. The change of clothing should be sent in a clear Ziplock bag*, labeled with your child's name. The bag with the clothing will be kept in school. It will be sent home when there is seasonal change for replacement clothing.</p>	
<p><u>An A4 box folder with elastic to close - any colour</u> (this will be the Friday folder) Preferably made of durable card not plastic.</p>	
<p><u>4 A4 envelope folders with a button - any colour</u> (to be kept in school)</p>	
<p><u>1 soft fabric pencil case with 2 pockets and zips, long enough to hold longer pencils with erasers.</u></p>	




<p><u>one glue stick, one eraser, and 10 colored pencils.</u> (NOT box pencil case).</p>	
<p><u>4 HB lead pencils</u> (Staedtler / Faber Castell / Pelican only)</p>	
<p><u>4 erasers</u></p>	
<p><u>1 box of 12 Jumbo size Carioca WASHABLE coloured marker pens.</u> Label box with your child's name. Please buy this brand as it really is washable!</p>	
<p><u>1 box of 12 thin colouring pencils</u> (e.g Staedtler / Faber Castell / Pelican are recommended as they sharpen well). Label box with your child's name.</p>	
<p><u>1 box of 12 thin wax crayons.</u> Label box with your child's name.</p>	
<p><u>5 large glue sticks - glue must be white in colour</u> (e.g Pritt / UHU). Glue should not be liquid.</p>	



<p><u>1 packet of various coloured play doh.</u> Label box with your child's name (PLEASE PURCHASE PLAY-DOH type)</p>	
<p><u>1 packet of DAS WHITE clay (500g).</u> Label packet with your child's name.</p>	

<p><u>1 pair of slip on rubber boots with no zips (wellington boots)</u> <u>Please label.</u></p>	
<p><u>1 art painting smock / apron with long sleeves and elastic at the wrist.</u> <u>Do not label with child's name.</u></p>

<p>1 blue notebook with 20 pages (top half of page is blank and bottom half is lined - please look carefully at page on photo)</p>

<p>Shoes</p>	<p>Shoes must be made for running or any kind of sports. Open shoes or sandals are not acceptable for PE.</p>
<p>Socks</p>	<p>Socks have to be above the ankle point so that they help protect students from twisted ankles and sprains.</p>
<p>Remember...</p>	<p>No jewelry should be worn for safety reasons as they can lead to injuries.</p> <p>Keep clothing marked with your child's name with permanent ink.</p>
