MORNING Car and Bus Arrival

- Car riders will begin unloading at 7:15 am. Students should wait until staff is on duty to exit the car. Due to student safety, cell phones are prohibited in carline. **Adults dropping off should not exit their car at any time. Students must exit the car on their own.**
- Car line ends at 7:45 am. Students should NOT exit cars after 7:45 am when teachers have reported to their classrooms. After 7:45, please drive around to the front office to sign in your child.
- *Car riders who plan to eat breakfast in the cafeteria need to arrive to school by 7:30 am.*
- Bus riders will arrive and begin unloading one bus at a time at 7:15 am.
- Breakfast is offered to ALL students.

AFTERNOON Car Line Dismissal

IMPORTANT:

- Due to student safety, cell phones are prohibited in carline.
- Car line drivers and passengers must WAIT inside their cars at all times. **No one should exit their car at any time.**
- Car seats/Booster seats should be on the passenger side of the backseat if needed. This will help carline run efficiently and quickly. Pull up out of carline if needed to assist the child.
- **YELLOW WEST** car tags numbers will only be used to call/identify students.

Procedure:

Students will sit quietly in their designated area while listening for their number to be called to load cars.

- **K-2 Car riders (circle drive):** Once student's number is called, student walks to the designated wait zone and loads once all cars have stopped. Cars MUST wait until directed by staff to exit.
- **3-6 Car riders (behind gym):** Once student's number is called, student walks from the designated area to the car and loads. Cars MUST wait until directed by staff to exit.
- **Walkers (Cafeteria foyer):** Parent must show walker pass to the teacher on duty before student will be released.
